Due to the school closures set by Governor Wolf and the PA Department of Education in response to the efforts to mitigate the spread of the Coronavirus, Cambria Heights Elementary School will be activating the use of our Flexible Instruction Days and distance learning. We will be continuing to connect with and educate our students while they remain in the safety and comfort of their own home. This plan may look a little different than the Cambria Heights Middle School and High School's plans due to the age and ability of our learners.

How will teachers deliver instruction?

On March 27, 2020, all students from the elementary school will have a work packet mailed to them created by their teachers. Students are asked to do their best on these assignments. **Packets must be returned by April 9th to have this work counted in their gradebook and as their attendance.** If we DO NOT return to school on April 7, packets can be returned any time before April 7 by one of the following methods:

1. Physically drop off the completed packet in the folder and envelope it came in by dropping it in the locked box located **outside** of the Cambria Heights Elementary main office doors.
2. Scan or take a picture of the work and email it to your child's homeroom teacher. Teachers' emails are located at the bottom of this document.
3. Mail the packet back to your child's homeroom teacher at:

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How long should my child work on the packet each day?

All the work that is sent home should only be worked on for a maximum of 1-2 hours a day with a scheduled “rest break” every 10-15 minutes while working.

What happens if the state closes our school for more days or weeks past April 6?

In every students’ packet that is mailed home will be directions for how to log on to an online Student Learning Platform called **Seesaw**. During the next week, we are asking all families to try their best to log on to the Seesaw website (web.seesaw.me) on a computer or laptop and/or download the Seesaw Class App on a tablet or phone.

What do I need to log on to Seesaw?

1. With adult assistance, students will need to use their SCHOOL ISSUED GOOGLE EMAIL ACCOUNT to create a Student Account on Seesaw.

2. Students will also need the Seesaw Class CODES to connect to their teacher’s specific classes. These directions and SPECIAL CODES will be in each student’s packet that will be mailed home on March 27.
3. **You must try to log on by April 1st as the codes will expire.** If you have any problems or if the code expires, email your teacher to receive a new code or assistance.

What will students do on Seesaw?

After April 7, if we are not in school, all assignments and activities will be posted and turned in using this online program. This program allows students, with the help of their parents, to complete online activities, record themselves reading, take pictures of work, receive directions for using other online programs, communicate with families, and many other activities.

What if I don't have a device?

- The district will have devices available to those students/families to borrow that do not have devices available to them.

- Arrangements will need to be made for you to pick up a Chromebook to borrow on Friday, March 27 between 9:00am-2:00pm at Cambria Heights Elementary School Main Office.

What if I can't find internet access?

Option#1: Some work can be completed on a cell phone, if possible.

Option #2: If your phone has a data plan, you can enable your "Personal Hotspot" in your phone's setting. This puts out a Wifi signal to any device in the room. Connect your child's device to your "Hotspot" signal using the password listed on your phone's screen in "Settings".
