



CAMBRIA HEIGHTS SCHOOL DISTRICT
INFORMATION FOR RETURN TO SCHOOL ON
February 1, 2021

Students in the Cambria Heights School District will return to in-person instruction starting Monday, February 1.

Students will report to their school buildings four days a week (Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays). All students will learn remotely on Wednesdays.

The following rules and guidelines will be in effect for students returning to school:

- All students and staff will wear masks inside the building - with the exception of during lunch - at all times. Currently, schools cannot open for in-person instruction without attesting to follow this guideline.
- Students will practice social distancing in the classrooms, hallways, and cafeteria *to the maximum extent possible*.
- Passengers and drivers will wear masks at all times while on buses.
- The health and safety protocols currently in place for athletics and after-school activities will remain in effect.
- Breakfast and lunch will continue to be available **free of charge to all students** for the remainder of the school year.
- ***If new Covid-19 cases are reported in an individual building, the district will follow Department of Health guidelines and close the building for a period of 3 - 14 days, depending upon the number of positive cases.*** Students should take their materials and devices home each evening in case their classes transition to remote learning.
- ***If your child is a close contact of someone who tests positive for Covid-19, you will receive an automated call from the school district; your child should quarantine and work remotely for 10 calendar days.***

Because Covid-19 protocols are still in place, parents have the option of selecting remote learning for their children at this time. ***If you would like your children to return to school following the same model as in the fall (either in-person or remote), you do not need to***

do anything at this time. If you would like to change your child's instructional model, please call any of your children's school buildings and inform the secretaries.
