Dear Students, Parents, and Guardians:

Over the past few days, Cambria Heights School District has received notice that several students and staff members have tested positive for Covid. Additionally, a larger number have to quarantine as a result of having direct contact with someone who has tested positive. While students in quarantine can work remotely through Google Classroom, when too many teachers are quarantined, we do not have enough faculty and staff in the buildings to supervise the students in socially-distanced settings.

As a result, all students in Cambria Heights School District will work remotely effective Thursday, November 12, through Tuesday, December 1. This period includes our scheduled Thanksgiving break. After Thanksgiving, the district will reassess cases in our area, specifically those affecting our students and staff, and announce how we will safely and effectively move forward.
