Dear Students, Parents, and Guardians:

At last night's meeting, the Cambria Heights School Board made the difficult decision to continue full remote learning in grades PK-12 until January 4, 2021. For the remainder of the 2020 calendar year, students will continue to log on to Google Classroom or Seesaw to access their teachers' instruction, which will include both synchronous and asynchronous lessons following the schedule established by the principal of each building. You may also call the office at your child(ren)'s school if you need supplies or materials, or if your child left belongings in his or her locker that you need between now and January.

Scheduled breaks will remain in effect for Thanksgiving (Thursday, November 26 - Monday, November 30) and Christmas (Thursday, December 24 - Sunday, January 3). Students will not have lessons or assignments during these days.

Until further notice, there will be no in-person extracurricular activities, interscholastic athletics, or open gyms. Coaches and advisors may meet with their students virtually.
