The explanation of the Rules and Procedures are as follows:

Class Rules and Procedures (B163 Mr. Manifest, Keystone Exam Prep)

1. Show respect to every person in the room at all times.

Example Unacceptable Behaviors BUT NOT ALL

- 3. Misuse of computers, including vandalism, stealing or forgery.
- 4. Disrespect towards the teacher and/or students in class.
- 5. Repeatedly out of work area.
- 6. Interfering with other students or their work.
- 7. Disrespect towards the teacher and/or students in class.
- 8. Littering in the classroom.

Grading Policy:

Students will be graded using both tests and projects. A due date will be given at the start of each project. Test dates will be announced at least two days in advance. If a student is absent the day before a test, he/she will still be expected to take the test on the announced day. When a student is absent, it is his/her responsibility to obtain make-up work the first day back to class. Make-ups will be given the day following the students return.

Total points earned from tests, quizzes, essays, daily assignments and projects will be converted to a percentage/letter grade.

Cheating and plagiarism are serious offenses and will not be tolerated. Any student who is found to be cheating on any assignment will receive a zero and school policy will be enforced.
