Dear Students, Parents, and Guardians:

This weekend, Cambria Heights School District was notified that a student in the elementary school has tested positive for Covid-19. In conjunction with the Pennsylvania Department of Health, the district conducted contact tracing and has identified a number of students (in Group B) and staff members who should quarantine according to Department of Health recommendations. As a result, Cambria Heights Elementary School students will work remotely from Monday, November 9 through Wednesday, November 18. Students will return to school for in-person instruction following our hybrid schedule on Thursday, November 19 (Group A) and Friday, November 20 (Group B).

If your child was one of the students who was in close contact, as defined by the CDC, with the affected student, you will receive a phone call from Mrs. Hilary Yahner, elementary school principal.

During this time, middle and high school students will report to school as scheduled.

As a reminder, no students will have remote assignments on Tuesday due to virtual parent-teacher conferences or Wednesday in observance of Veteran's Day.
