Dear Students, Parents, and Guardians:

At a special meeting last night, the Cambria Heights school board elected to continue to follow the hybrid schedule that our students have been following since the start of the year. Although our board, administration, teachers, and community were all eager to see our students return for daily, in-person instruction, both the Pennsylvania Departments of Health and Education have recommended that Cambria County schools follow a hybrid or remote learning model given our county's recent designation in the "significant" category of transmission risk. Since the start of the school year, two individuals associated with Cambria Heights School District have tested positive for Covid-19. Our hybrid model has allowed for social distancing such that no students have had to quarantine as a result.

Each school building will send out additional correspondence related to the hybrid instructional model. If you have any questions, you may contact your child(ren)'s principal at his or her school.

As a reminder, next Tuesday, November 9, is parent-teacher conference day. Each school has already sent out invitations for scheduling virtual conferences with teachers.

The school board meets again on November 17, at which time the board and administration will revisit the option of returning all students to in-person learning.
