

Memorandum: Cambria Heights School District Delinquent Account Policy

To: CHSD Parents

Effective for the start of the 2015-2016 school year, an alternative meal consisting of a cheese sandwich, fruit, vegetable and milk, or the meal equivalent, will be provided to students who accrue a debt of five (5) charged meals or greater.

The district provides an advance payment service that establishes an account for each student from which meals are debited. Failure to maintain a positive balance in such an account will lead to loss of debit privileges.

After three (3) charged meals, a written warning will be given to the student, parents and guardians, The written warning will include an explanation that after the student has received five (5) charged meals, payment will be required or the alternative meal will be provided and the student/parent/guardian will be charged the regular amount. The warning will indicate the number of charged meals the student has received during the current year and the dollar amount owed for previous meals.
