Earlier today, the district was notified that an employee of Cambria Heights High School has tested positive for Covid-19. Fortunately, no students have been deemed to have had close contact with this employee and none will need to quarantine at this time. The district will notify those students who did have contact with the employee for fewer than 15 minutes so their parents will have the option to have their children self-quarantine out of caution.

Out of an abundance of caution, Cambria Heights High School and Middle School students will work remotely from Monday, November 2 through Wednesday, November 4. Students will receive instructions from their teachers on Monday morning by 9:00 AM via Google Classroom.

Cambria Heights Elementary School students will remain on the hybrid schedule to start the week, with Group A reporting for in-person instruction tomorrow and Group B students reporting on Tuesday. All students will work remotely on Wednesday as previously scheduled.

All after-school activities that practice or meet outdoors will continue as scheduled, with all participants being screened for symptoms daily. Activities that take place indoors will be postponed until Thursday, November 5.

High school students who attend Admiral Peary must also complete their vo-tech assignments remotely through Wednesday.
